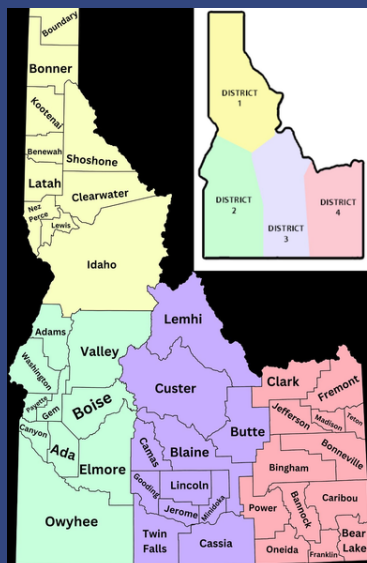

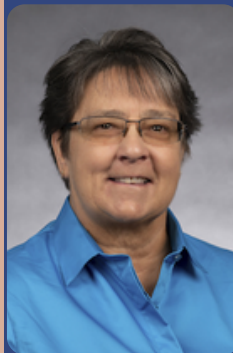

INVITE A LEGISLATOR CAMPAIGN



What? The Governmental Affairs Committee is challenging each IATA athletic trainer to invite at least one, if not all three, of their appointed district legislators, to an event or tour of their workplace this fall.

Why? We want to strengthen our relationships with our legislators and continue to educate on the nuances and uniqueness of our athletic training profession. These visits will give them a closer look into the world of athletic training.

Where? These visits will take place at your workplace, whether that be a high school, college, classroom, military base, industrial warehouse, etc. Visits will ideally include a tour of your athletic training facility/clinic and when able, an intimate perspective to a game, ceremony, presentation, etc.

When? Our goal is to have all legislator visits take place from September to November, so it is important to start planning and getting those invitations out. The reason behind this is to have a cohesive state effort which will demonstrate a strong presence within the Capitol.

How? We are providing a toolkit for ATs to use which will include a graphic of choice dependent on setting, an adaptable letter invitation template and an etiquette checklist. These items will be available on the IATA website, under the GAC page. Should an athletic trainer desire a different type of graphic, please reach out to Lauren Hoyt and you can work together to create something more specific to your setting or event.

D10 UPDATE

In spring of 2024 a vote will take place on a membership dues increase of \$25.
