#### **GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION**

LECTURE SESSION

Thank you for your interest in lecture abstract submission! The Research & Education Committee will review each abstract and review them for integrity and bias through a review process to provide a robust up to date educational experience for the summer symposium. Please see the below details on format, guidelines, presentation information, and deadline for your submission.

## Format & Audience

- Lectures need to be 50-55 minutes in length with an expected 5–10-minute question-and-answer period.
- This presentation is either a single presenter or two speakers. No more.
- Audience consists of Certified Athletic Trainers

#### Guidelines

- Proposal topics must fall within one of the five domains of practice for athletic training. Detailed domain information can be found in the Board of Certification Practice Analysis.
- Proposal submissions must avoid any affiliation with a commercial product or service.
- Proposals must be complete and accurate with confirmed topic and list of speakers. Incomplete or late proposals will not be considered.
- After July 1, 2024 the Research & Education Committee will only approve a speaker change if the original speaker is unable to attend the convention.

#### **Presentation Information**

- Title
- Domain(s) the presentation pertains to (I, II, III, IV, V).
- Abstract: 150 words or less
- State learning objectives (at least three)
- Clinical bottom line
- Three to five references/sources that support the presentation
- Speaker information for each speaker
  - o Name & Credentials
  - o Title or position
  - o Place of employment or affiliation including name and address
  - o Contact information including email and phone number
  - o NATA membership status (member or non-member)
  - o CV or resume (word document or pdf)
  - o Speaker Qualification Form

# **Deadline**

- Abstracts must be submitted no later than Monday, May 6th, 2024 to be accepted.
- Incomplete and/or late abstracts will NOT be accepted.
